Alabama Tax Forms Mailed

Montgomery, Jan. 10, 2000—The end of December marked the beginning of the Alabama Department of Revenue's annual mailout of state individual income tax returns, announced State Revenue Commissioner George E. Mingledorff III.

The mailout began on Dec. 28, 1999, and will end on Jan. 15, 2000, resulting in over 650,000 returns being mailed to Alabama taxpayers.

According to Mingledorff, this year's mailout is a little different, compared to past years'. "This year, we are actually mailing fewer tax booklets since filing trends by many taxpayers indicate they either choose to use returns provided by their paid preparers or choose to electronically file their Alabama returns," said Mingledorff. "Last year, approximately 588,000 taxpayers chose not to use their state-provided returns but opted to use returns provided by their paid preparers, and over 200,000 filed their 1998 state returns electronically," explained Mingledorff.

Taxpayers who chose to use returns provided by their paid preparers or who chose to electronically file their Alabama returns for the 1998 tax year will not be included in the annual mailout of returns.

As in past tax seasons, the department will continue to supply area post offices, public libraries, and various state office buildings with state tax returns. Beginning Jan. 4, 2000, through Jan. 15, 2000, the department will mail bulk quantities of the 1999 Alabama returns to various public outlets for distribution.

Individuals having Internet access may download state tax forms and schedules from the Revenue Department's Web site at www.ador.state.al.us. The department's Web site also features a link with the IRS for federal tax return information.
